2009 Campaign Celebration

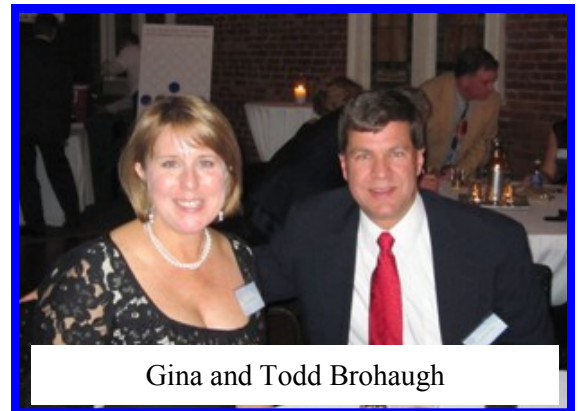
